Not a sightseeing event!

Upper Campus in Educational Buildings:

Immediately go to an interior part of the building trying to put as many walls as possible between you and the outside. Stay away from windows, doors, and outside walls. Remain in the safety locations until the siren no longer sounds.

Safety locations are posted in buildings.

Upper Campus:

When the storm sirens go off, **it's not safe to be running from housing all the way across campus to another building.** Depending on the time of day or night, there may be limited access to education buildings on upper campus due to locked doors.

Know Storm Procedure in Dorms

At the activation of the sirens, students should seek shelter in the designated tornado shelter areas of their respective dorm residences.

Bluestem Halls & Cottonwood: Rms 101-355

Shelter locations are the bathrooms/interior hallways of the lowest level.

Bison: Units 1-2 & 5-8 Meadowlark: Units 15-20

Sunflower Halls: Units 21-34

Shelter locations are the bathrooms/hallways.

Take a pillow and/or mattress to cover up with in order to be protected from possible falling debris. Stay away from windows. Stay in your shelter area.

The siren will blow continuously until the immediate danger is over.
