Fort Riley Campus

- Consolidated service locations resulting in a reduction to overhead costs to the College
- Provided subject matter assistance in the recent submissions of the DoD Compliance Audit and provided feedback/assistance in the revision of College policies related to the audit

Grandview Plaza Campus

- Selected to host the IBSMART (Institute for Basic Spill Management and Response Training (IBSMART)) training for health and safety trainers from across the U.S. in April of 2024, James Henderson was the master trainer for this event
- Secured a 5 year contract to be the sole provider of HHW training for the State of Kansas this year

Fort Leavenworth Campus

- Increased advertising to include a banner at the post movie theater, an advertisement before each movie plays, and a short advertisement on 11 self-checkout display screens at the post Commissary
- Requested by the Army Corrections Brigade to staff a service provider table to provide information about Barton's programs to military service members/families at the Griffin Family Wellness Day
- Staff attend all new-comer briefings to speak with service members, DoD employees, and family members that recently arrived on Fort Leavenworth

END 6 Barton Services & Regional Locations Are there any challenges to address?

Fort Riley Campus

- Three year decline in Academic program enrollments (2021=2,864; 2022=2,486; 2023=2,364)
- One year decline in MLTR class enrollments (2021=2,067; 2022=2,908; 2023=2,291)
- Lack of OER Certified courses at the Barton County Campus to supplement our LSEC and CP offerings
- Inefficient layout of the Fort Riley Student Services Office and a lack of budgetary resources to make improvements

Grandview Plaza Campus

- Declining enrollment in the EMHS program
- Slow response time to some building repair/improvement related issues

Fort Leavenworth Campus

- Three year decline in enrollments (2021=1,345; 2022=1,167; 2023=944)
- Retention of students needing extra academic support (academic coaching, academic advising, tutoring, etc.)
- Inability/resistance in connecting with USD 207 to inform them on how Barton can support students and faculty to promote dual enrollment for HS students
