- Short Term
 - Identify a target audience, i.e. high school students and offer a Career Awareness Seminar online – consider offering the seminar with scholarships funds and requesting no state aid reimbursement
 - Approximate cost \$10,000 per 200 students
 - Possible feeder for increased CTE enrollment
- Long Term
 - Restore Alternative Programming
 - Two Staff Positions (Coordinator & Support Staff)
 - \$25,000 Programming Budget
 - \$10,000 Promotional Budget
 - o Blend of Credit/Non-Credit Offerings (Face-to-Face & Online)
