Students will acquire the skills needed to be successful for the program they are in.

- Students will have the essential skills to succeed in the workplace.
- Students will have the essential skills to lead productive lives.
- Students will be provided remediation as needed.

The attached data reports reflect that the college is having positive outcomes on the three measures stated above. The data comes from the graduation survey, alumni survey and developmental reports.

Graduation survey reflects a valid percentage of 98.5% of graduates who believed that classroom experiences prepared them in the area of critical thinking.

The Alumni Survey confirmed several positive outcomes. First when ask if they had ever been employed full-time or part-time in their field of study Barton received a valid percent of 62.9%. Questioning if they are employed the responders reported a valid percentage of 75.7% were full-time and 15.7% part-time. Determining if Barton prepared them for employment in their field Barton received a valid percent of 81.2% of respondents were well or very well prepared. Another encouraging report was full-time annual earnings reporting a valid percent of 77.7% making \$20,000 or above.


Assessment and Placement Report confirms that 76.8% of full-time students have assessment scores on file. Knowing that our Barton County Campus enrollment is usually around 1200 students then students off campus are taking advantage of the assessment opportunity. Those scores reflect that 51.3% of students tested developmental in at least one area and 59.8% of those students take advantage of developmental courses.

Developmental Pass Rates are another excellent demonstration of student success through remediation as 68% of Math, 76% of English and 64% of Reading students successfully complete their courses.

Rate how well your classroom experiences at Barton prepared you in the area of Critical Thinking



Rate how well your classroom experiences at Barton prepared you in the area of Critical Thinking.








