


Barton's in-state T&F is \$97 per credit hour. Barton provides a \$7 per credit hour scholarship to students residing in Barton County (In-District).




## FY15 Non Resident Tuition & Fees







## **FY15 Online Tuition & Fees**




Online rates as reported to KBOR. EduKan rate is currently \$135 (increasing to \$147 next fall). Many of these colleges have limited online programs.






### March 26, 2015 Board Meeting – Tuition & Fees

**Detail:** The revenue for the college for the next fiscal year is projected to decrease due to decreases in funding from the State of Kansas & Property Tax revenue. This reduction in conjunction with increasing operating costs requires an increase in tuition. Information has been provided to the Board outlining various options and the revenue that would be generated for each option.

**Recommendation:** The college administration is recommending the following tuition changes for Fall FY16 (effective fall 201601). This is an increase in tuition of \$3 per credit hour for all student sectors. This increase will generate approximately \$216,000 in additional revenue for FY16.

General and individual Course fees are unchanged and are in addition to the tuition.
