Occupational Safety & Health Degree and Certificates Executive Summary

Purpose/Goal

- In 2012 Barton was awarded the designation (non-monetary 5 year contract) of "OSHA Training Institute Education Center, OTIEC" which not only authorized Barton to offer 48 different OSHA courses but required us to offer most of them annually. Along with the authorization to offer the classes came the expectation that we must also offer several certificate s that are authorized by OSHA.
- The certificates, SAP's were disapproved by KBOR as we lacked a safety degree to tie them to.
- There is no other AAS safety degrees being offered by a public institution in the state of Kansas.
- Our goal is to stand up the AAS degree and several certificates.
- The degree will be offered resident as well as online with the certificates only being offered resident (OSHA restriction).

Certificates

- The certificates are OSHA certificates not Barton's however we have written syllabi for each class so the certificates would be eligible for VA and count as major electives for the degree.
 - Specialist In Safety & Health, SSH (General Industry) (6.5 credits)
 - Specialist In Safety & Health, SSH (Construction Industry) (6.5 credits)
 - Certified Safety & Health Official, CSHO (General Industry) (14 Credits)
 - o Certified Safety & Health Official, CSHO (Construction Industry) (14 Credits)
- These certifications are offered by all 42 OSHA Education Centers http://www.bartonsafety.org/certificates.html

Degree:

- This would be the only Occupational Safety & Health 2 year Degree in the state offered by a public institution.
- Will be adding the degree to our Fort Riley Military programs as well as Online and after hours.
- Fort Leonard Wood is also interested in us offering the degree.

Overall Rationale:

- With KBOR not approving the certificates without a degree as well as Fort Riley, Fort Leonard Wood, several business & industry, and Kansas Department of Labor supporting the development of the degree it makes sense for us to proceed.
- We also have students who have completed our Hazmat degree and certificates who have asked why we don't offer a safety degree.
- It complements our designation of OSHA Education Center.
- Fits in with our PETE and CCCHST partnership and future plans.
