Types of Positions

- EMR: ***Most are not hiring EMR, these are part-time, volunteers
 - Estimated salary \$25k 30k
- EMT: salary \$35k- 45k
- **AEMT:** salary \$40k-50k
- Paramedic: salary \$50k-70k

Salary

- Hourly wage does not account for Overtime, On-call Time, Training, Extra Shifts, or working a second EMS job at the same service.
- EMS works about 9-11, 24 hr. days/month
