Revenue Neutral Hearing

Senate Bill 13 requires that the County be notified of our intent to exceed the revenue neutral date by July 20th. This notification was sent to Barton County. The notice of the intent to exceed the revenue neutral rate is provided below. Senate Bill 13 requires that the Board of Trustees publish this notice as well as provide a hearing for answering objections from taxpayers.

The law also requires that the Board of Trustees vote on a resolution to exceed the revenue neutral rate. The proposed published budget sets a mill levy at 28.634 mills. This mill rate is revenue neutral which means we are not requesting additional tax dollars. The county's estimated valuation increased this past year mainly due to real estate, personal property, and utilities. The mill levy request is based on the valuation number provided by the County on June 27, 2023.

Prior to SB13, the Board of Trustees had typically attempted to keep the mill levy the same from year to year which results in decreases/increases in revenue based on the final valuation which is certified in November of each year.
