The SSS program has 3 objectives:

1. Increase the persistence rate of students from one year to the next.
2. Increase the amount of students in Good Academic Standing
3. Increase the graduation rate.

We meet these objectives with invasive support structures, tutoring, academic workshops and mentoring.
