Service

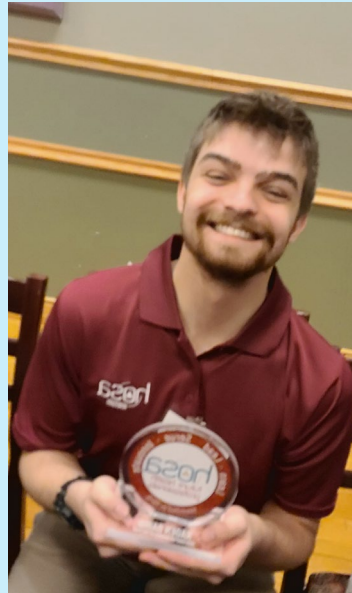
- Bone marrow donor registry drive as a group - NMDP
