## Resources Supporting Academic Advancement

- ✓ Transfer Fairs –
  - Student Services and TRIO/SSS host transfer fairs each fall and spring  
approx. 20 four-year institutions participate – Feb. 3, 2026
- ✓ TRIO/Student Support Services Transfer Visits –
  - SSS provides approximately 6 group transfer visits each semester for students
  - SSS provides individual transfer visits for program participants when needed/requested
- ✓ University Representative Visits -
  - Student Services schedules and Library hosts university admissions representatives throughout the fall and spring terms
