Exam Dates

October and March each year

Exam may be taken until student passes

EMS

Practical Exams and Written Exams

EMT – 5 stations

AEMT – 8 stations

Paramedic – 12 stations

Most practical test sites allows for same day retest. If a student fails half their stations, they will not be allowed to retest. If they miss less than half, they can retest any failed stations that day.

If practical test site doesn't have same day retests or they fail twice in one day, students can take it at any time. There is no time limit between tests. The student must find a test site that will allow them into test their site. It can be in-state or out-of-state.

If the student fails the written exam, they have to wait 15 days to apply again.

EMS Overall Testing

Students have two years and six attempts to become certified.

However, if the student fails anything three times; they will have to do a 48 our refresher before they can attempt a fourth exam.

If student fails anything six times; they must repeat the course.

MLT

American Society of Clinical Pathology (ASCP)

ASCP will allow you to reapply to retake the exam the day after you fail.

The new guidelines are five times before remediation (BCC prefers that after 2nd failed attempt, the student see us for remediation).

RN and PN

If a student does not pass on the first attempt, they may retake in 45 days. This is the same for subsequent retakes.

After 5 years from graduation, the individual must retake their nursing courses.

Information from the Kansas Nurse Practice Act: If an individual fails to pass the licensure examination within 24 months from graduation, the individual shall petition the board in writing before being allowed to retake the licensure examination. The petition shall be on a form provided by the board.

CNA and CMA

Students may take the exams two times. If unsuccessful, they must retake the course.
