This year's Higher Education Day in Topeka will once again be a "must attend" event. Please bring your mascots for the event to share in the fun. You should plan on staffing your table from **7:30 a.m. until about 1:30 or 2:00**.

Breakfast is served from 7:30 – 9:00 a.m. on the Second Floor, north. Regents, CEOs and all of the legislature is invited. You can catch most legislators going to or returning from breakfast. Unfortunately, we cannot get in and begin setting up our tables until 7:30 that morning, so you should plan on exactly what you want to ensure legislators see and know about your college and your students and be ready to dazzle them with your brilliance. **Quick set-up is to your advantage.**

It will be **first come, first serve** to the tables and your placement in the 2nd floor rotunda. The tables are six foot tables, and if you need power, you need to bring your own extension cords. (Sorry, those are the rules.)

If you did not attend last year, please find a crew who can represent your college well. All public universities, tech colleges and community colleges are able to participate, and it is noticeable when you do not attend. I always think positive noticing is better than negative noticing.

If you are bringing your mascot, please let me know ahead of time, so I can inform the folks who need to know to get your mascot for pictures, etc. They can change into their mascot uniforms in the 2nd floor south, Lt. Governor's conference room.
