- Opened spring 1978 as a preschool
 - Had 2 children
- Original Purpose
 - Lab setting for Child Care & Guidance Program
 - Provide day care for Barton's students first and if there were openings, for staff/faculty
- Expansion, 1997
 - infants, school age, and SRS children



- New Building, 2000
 - Infants thru school age.
 - Licensed for 60 kids
- Staff
 - 5 full time (including director) & 2 part time
 - 14 student employees (reduced from typical)
- Staff training



- Child care/preschool, currently serving:
 - 2 Barton students (4%)
 - 12 staff/faculty (26%)
 - 33 community members (70%)
- Lab setting, Child Care & Guidance Program:
 - Approximately 4 students a year
 - Job shadowing for about 3-4 UB students in summer



- Benefits to Barton employees
 - General availability of care in local communities
 - location
 - Access for nursing mothers
 - Parent participation (donuts with grownups, Halloween parade, Easter egg hunt, etc.)
 - Long tenure of care providers
 - average: 12 years



- Benefits to community
 - Training of qualified care providers
 - Former CDC workers employed in education in local communities (12+) & Wichita, Kansas City, Texas, Salina
 - General availability of care in local communities
 - Parents employed in local public service, K-12 schools, & health care, police, EMS (20), etc.
 - Pre-school prep MTSS aligned
 - Long tenure of care providers
 - average: 12 years 5 full time, 2 part time



- College commitment
 - 5 year average annual loss: approx. \$139,853
 - Not including transportation expenses for field trips and transporting school agers to and from schools in GB
 - Activity/performance facility usage
 - Swimming pool, practice gyms, performing arts spaces
 - Professional Development funding
 - Facility updates in December 2020
 - First in 20 years
 - \$11,300.00
