August 31, 2021 Financial Statement summary for Board Study Session September 14, 2021:

As you will see the Tuition revenue is down as compared to the same time last year. This is due to lower enrollment as compared to the same date last year. At the same time, AR is up approximately a million dollars. Many of these student are on payment plans and/or have until the end of the semester to pay for their current classes. Due to COVID, this is the first semester since Spring of 2020 that students are required to pay for past due balances prior to enrolling. The business office cleared a large number of past due balances within the last two weeks.

The State Aid revenue is up due to a one time grant via the state. This is also associated with COVID expenditures. Our actual State Aid has not increased.

The other major difference is the "other" revenue. Most of this influx of COVID revenue is reimbursements for dollars spent/lost revenue from this past fiscal year. Expenditures of these funds are restricted, and we are currently undergoing an audit of the expenditures/revenues up until June 30.

Expenditures are running a little higher than what would typically be expected, however they are mainly due to paying 100% of the property insurance upfront this year as compared to monthly installments last year. In addition, there are COVID expenditures, additional IT and Library subscriptions/contracts that always pay out at the start of the fiscal year. This percentage should start to level off as the year progresses.
