

## **BARTON** OSHA DTE Audits and Results



All OTI Education Centers (OTIECs) are required to develop and maintain controls necessary to ensure and verify the accuracy of the number of students trained, validate the attendance of each student for each day of the course, verify students meet all applicable prerequisite requirements, ensure student surveys are completed and confirm that instructors meet appropriate requirements.

On 11/5/21, the following documentation for five courses recently facilitated by the GPOEC were audited by OSHA DTE: 1) daily sign-in sheets, 2) verification of prerequisite qualifications for each student, 3) student surveys, and 4) Instructor qualifications to include: documentation that the instructor has completed 30 hours of occupational safety and health training within the last five years, and has completed at least seven hours of training in the subject area of teaching adults within the last five years.

OSHA recently reviewed attendance documentation for five courses presented by Great Plains OSHA Education Center (GPOEC) during FY 2021Q4. All required documentation was completed in accordance with program policy and procedures.

## Partnering with Other Barton Programs



- The OSHA Program supports the Hazardous Materials Management Program (Lindsay Holmes) in the PETE 80hr Hazardous Waste Worker Training (HWWT) Agreement with instruction by OSH Program faculty and generation of OSHA DTE Certificates for 15 OSHA classes
  - Only an OTIEC can issue OSHA DTE Certificates
  - Without our designation an OTIEC, we would be unable to meet the terms of the current HWWT agreement with PETE
- The OSHA Program supports the WTCE Welding Program (Mary Foley) in facilitating the OSHA 10hr General Industry class once per Semester
  - One hour per day over a 12-day period
