Title IX

Reporting discrimination Barton Policy

- All employees are mandatory reporters, except:
 - College nurse
 - Mental health counselor

Title IX

- Receipt of report—what then?
- Anonymous reports
 - Generally from anonymous reporting form on Title IX webpage
 - Barton may be limited in ability to respond
 - Investigate to extent possible

Title IX

- Under current regulations, if there is a known complainant and “Big 6” allegations, cannot investigate until a formal complaint is filed

Title IX

- “Big 6” include
 - hostile environment sexual harassment
 - Sexual assault
 - Dating violence
 - Domestic violence
 - Stalking
 - Quid pro quo

Title IX

- Other Title IX offenses
 - Nonconsensual taking pix or videos of intimate activities
 - Nonconsensual distribution of pix or videos of intimate activities
 - Knowingly transmitting STD/STI or HIV
 - Fondling
 - Engaging in sex trafficking/prostituting another person
 - Bullying/hazing
 - Misappropriation of another's identity
 - Blackmail via threats to post images/info showing another person's nudity or sexual activity
 - Causing or attempting to cause incapacitation for nonconsensual sexual activity
 - Retaliation

Title IX

- All discrimination claims are governed by Barton Policy 1132
- “Big 6” claims managed under Policy 1132 Process A (live hearing)
- Other parts of Title IX and other discrimination comes under Process B (no live hearing)

Title IX

- Complainants
 - They decide whether to file complaint
 - Except where danger to others is posed by Respondent
 - Options are explained to Complainant
 - File formal complaint
 - Can do Informal Resolution if all agree
 - Investigation and live hearing

Title IX

- Supportive measures:
 - Purpose is to preserve access to Barton's educational activities & programs

Title IX

- Offer Supportive Measures
 - Referral to counseling, healthcare
 - Referral to Family Crisis Center
 - Alter housing
 - Alter work arrangements
 - No Contact Orders
 - Campus Safety Escorts
 - Class schedule modifications, withdrawals or leaves of absence
 - Extension of time –assignments and testing
